

# BISSC IN-HOUSE TRAINED INSPECTOR CERTIFICATION

<b>Description:</b>	The BISSC In-house Trained Inspector Certification identifies individuals who have received instruction on how to interpret and apply the ANSI/ASB/Z50.2 standard to equipment design. This person is qualified and certified to authorize equipment certification as established by the Baking Industry Sanitation Standards Committee.
<b>Certification Requirements:</b>	Completion of the <a href="#">Certified Equipment Design for BISSC Certification</a> course (public or private in-plant)
<b>Certification Period:</b>	4 years (through December 31 of the fourth year)

## RECERTIFICATION INFORMATION:

<b>Recertification Options:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete the online BISSC In-house Trained Inspector recertification exam</li> <li>• Retake the <a href="#">Certified Equipment Design for BISSC Certification</a> course</li> </ul>
<b>Timing:</b>	Either the online exam or the course must be successfully completed within the calendar year the certification will expire.
<b>Recertification Fee:</b>	The cost of the recertification exam or course.
<b>Notification of Expiration:</b>	As a courtesy, AIB will send email notifications prior to the certification expiration date. <b>It is the responsibility of the person holding the certification to ensure their email information is current in AIB's database.</b>
<b>Lapsed Certifications:</b>	If a BISSC In-house Trained Inspector fails to successfully complete one of the recertification options prior to the expiration date, the certification is considered expired. In order to re-establish the certification, the individual would need to attend the <a href="#">Certified Equipment Design for BISSC Certification</a> course to restart the certification cycle.
