

ANSI Z50.2 Inspector Certification/ Recertification

Description:	The ANSI Z50.2 Inspector Certification/Recertification identifies individuals who have received instruction on how to interpret and apply the ANSI/ASB/Z50.2 standard to equipment design. This person is qualified and certified to authorize equipment certification as established by the Baking Industry Sanitation Standards Committee.
Certification Requirements:	Completion of the <i>Sanitary Design Course for Equipment Certification</i> course (public or private in-plant)
Certification Period:	4 years (through December 31 of the fourth year)

Recertification Options:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete the online ANSI Z50.2 Inspector Certification/Recertification exam • Retake the <i>Sanitary Design Course for Equipment Certification</i> course
Timing:	Either the online exam or the course must be successfully completed within the calendar year the certification will expire.
Recertification Fee:	The cost of the recertification exam or course.
Notification of Expiration:	As a courtesy, AIB will send email notifications prior to the certification expiration date. It is the responsibility of the person holding the certification to ensure their email information is current in AIB's database.
Lapsed Certifications:	If a ANSI Z50.2 Trained Inspector fails to successfully complete one of the recertification options prior to the expiration date, the certification is considered expired. In order to re-establish the certification, the individual would need to attend the <i>Sanitary Design Course for Equipment Certification</i> course to restart the certification cycle.
